Understanding Our Adversary

Intro:

- 1. Peter warned early Christians, "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour" (1 Pet. 5:8).
- 2. Paul warned early Christians, "lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices" (2 Cor. 2:11).
- 3. We can learn a lot about our adversary from his first arrival in the Garden scene, Genesis 3:1-5.

Discussion:

I. HIS CHARACTER IS CUNNING (Gen. 3:1a)

- A. The serpent is Satan, Revelation 12:9, 20:2.
- B. To be cunning is to be crafty, shrewd, and sly.
- C. 2 Corinthians 11:3, "But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ."
- D. Transforms into an angel of light to work deceit, 2 Corinthians 11:14, 15.

II. HIS TACTICS (Gen. 3:1b-5)

- A. He questions God's word (Gen. 3:1).
- B. He contradicts God's word with his tale of lies (Gen. 3:4).
 - 1. Ephesians 5:31. "Marriage is **not** between a man and a woman."
 - 2. Titus 1:6. "Elders must **not** have faithful children."
 - 3. Hebrews 10:25. "You need **not** assemble every service."
 - 4. Ephesians 4:4, 1:22, 23. "There is **not** one church."
 - 5. Colossians 3:17. "You need **not** have authority for everything you say and do."
 - 6. 1 Peter 3:21. "Baptism does **not** save us today."
- C. He redefines God's character (Gen. 3:5).
 - 1. "God is too restrictive and is withholding good from you."
 - 2. "The grass is always greener on the other side of the fence."

Conclusion:

- 1. Do not get tied up in Satan's "nots."
- Proverbs 3:5, "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding."
